TB Free Rajasthan

- **○** Why in News?
- 'Active Tuberculosis Search Campaign' is being run in Rajasthan from 25 June to 21 July 2025.
- **Main Point**
- Through this campaign, so far, more than 74 lakh (44 percent) of the highly vulnerable population has been screened door-to-door.



- Aim of the campaign: To conduct TB tests of 1.67 crore vulnerable persons of the state.
- Objective: To provide timely free treatment by quickly identifying hidden cases of TB.
- Under the campaign, door-to-door screening of PLHIV (People Living with HIV), diabetes patients, people above 60 years of age, malnourished persons, smokers, alcoholics, migrant workers, tribal communities, former TB patients and people living in mining and construction sites, jails and urban slums is being done.

Other important points:

- NAAT technology: Nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT) has been used as a tool for diagnosing tuberculosis (TB).
- Nikshay Portal: Real-time monitoring of identification, treatment and payment of TB patients is ensured through this portal.

• Tuberculosis (TB): Tuberculosis (TB) is a bacterial infection caused by a bacterium called Mycobacterium tuberculosis. This disease mainly affects the lungs, but it can also affect other parts of the body like stomach, glands, bones and nervous system.

Facts for Prelims:

Pradhan Mantri TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan:

- Start 9 September 2022
- Related Ministry Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Government of India)
- Target Elimination of TB by the year 2025.
- Note: The global target for TB elimination is the year 2030.

'TB Free Panchayat' Initiative:

- On 24 March 2023, World Tuberculosis Day, the Prime Minister inaugurated the 'One World TB Summit 2023' held in Varanasi and launched the 'TB Free Panchayat' initiative.
- It is the official pan-India initiative for short-term preventive treatment and family-centred care model for TB.

Global Effort:

- The "Find. Treat. All. #EndTB" joint initiative has been launched by the World Health Organization (WHO) along with the Global Fund and the Stop TB Partnership.
- World Tuberculosis Day is observed every year on 24 March.
- Theme for the year 2025: "Yes! We Can End TB: Commit, Invest, Deliver

Main Point

- This scheme is the first specific scheme focused on agriculture and allied sectors.
- It was announced in the Union Budget 2025-26.
- This scheme will be implemented in 100 districts across the country from the year 2025-26.
- These 100 districts will be determined on the basis of three major indicators such as low productivity, low cropping intensity and low loan disbursement.
- This scheme is inspired by the Aspirational District Program.
- This scheme will be implemented in 36 existing schemes of 11 departments, other schemes of the states and local participation of the private sector.
- About 1.7 crore small and marginal farmers will benefit from this program.
- Objective of the scheme: Increasing agricultural productivity, adopting crop diversification and sustainable agricultural practices, increasing post-harvest storage capacity at Panchayat and Block level, improving irrigation facilities and facilitating availability of long term and short term loans.

Maharashtra Maritime Summit 2025

- Why in News?
- Maharashtra Maritime Summit 2025 was organized in Mumbai on July 16, 2025.



- **Main Point**
- **Organiser:** Network Times.
- Collaboration: Organised in collaboration with Maharashtra Maritime Board, Ministry of Fisheries and Ports and Government of Maharashtra.
- **Summit inaugurated by:** Devendra Fadnavis (Chief Minister, Maharashtra)
- Main objective of the summit: To set the direction for sustainable, inclusive and globally competitive maritime development in Maharashtra.
- Topics like port development, green logistics, green maritime technology and employment generation were discussed in the summit.

New base year of Gross Domestic Product (GDP): 2022-23

- **○** Why in News?
- Recently, the Government of India has announced to change the base year for calculating Gross Domestic Product (GDP) from 2011-12 to 2022-23 with the aim of increasing the accuracy of economic assessments.



- Main Point
- This amendment is being made for the first time in more than a decade.
- Formation of Advisory Committee: A 26-member Advisory Committee on National Accounts Statistics (ACNAS) has been formed to improve the National Accounts Statistics.
 - o Chairman: Biswanath Goldar.
 - o Members: Representatives from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Central and State Governments, academics and researchers.
 - o Main functions of the Committee: To identify new data sources and refine the methodology of compiling national accounts data under the revised series and work towards guiding the revision.
- Implementation timeline: The revised GDP series based on 2022-23 base year is likely to be implemented by early 2026.

Experts believe that ideally the base year should be revised every 5 years to keep the national accounts in line with the latest available data so that the economic data remains relevant with changing times.

Other important points:

Base Year:

- The base year is a specific reference year against which the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) data of the upcoming and previous years is calculated.
- In the last base year revision done in the year 2015, the base year was changed from the year 2004-05 to the year 2011-12.
- Features: The base year must be a normal year, i.e. no abnormal event like drought, flood, earthquake, epidemic etc. should occur in this year. Also, there should not be much difference in the interval between the years.
- History of Base Year Revision: The first national income estimates were published in the year 1956 with the financial year 1949 as the base year, since then India has revised its base year seven times.

Article 326 of Indian Constitution

- **♦** Why in News?
- Recently, the Election Commission of India has started Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of voter lists ahead of Bihar Assembly elections.



- **♦** Main Point
- Objective of revision: To include new voters who have attained the age of 18 years, remove names of dead or duplicate voters, correct inaccuracies, prevent electoral fraud and ensure a credible polling process.
- The move has sparked controversy among opposition parties and activists, as they have alleged disenfranchisement of certain communities and new voters.
- The Commission has justified the revision under its constitutional authority under Article 326 of the Indian Constitution.

Other Important Points:

Article 326:

- Provides the right to vote in Lok Sabha and state assembly elections to every Indian citizen of the age of 18 years or above.
- It establishes universal adult suffrage, ensuring that no citizen shall be denied the right to vote for any reason other than those prescribed by law.
- Grounds for disenfranchisement: Non-residency, unsoundness of mind, criminal conviction or corrupt electoral practice, etc.
- Mandate of Election Commission under Article 326: The Election Commission is constitutionally mandated to maintain accurate and up-to-date electoral rolls. This includes deleting duplicate, ineligible or outdated entries and adding new eligible voters.
- Petitions challenging this amendment were filed in the Supreme Court, raising important questions about the balance between electoral integrity and inclusiveness.
- Article 326 of the Indian Constitution provides the right to vote to every adult citizen, which was lowered from 21 years to 18 years by the 61st Constitutional Amendment in 1989.

Key contentions:

- In Kuldip Nair v. Union of India (2006), the Supreme Court held that the 'right to vote' is a statutory right and not a fundamental or constitutional right.
- Justice Ajay Rastogi dissented in Anoop Barnwal v. Union of India (2023) and viewed the 'right to vote' as a manifestation of Articles 19(1)(A) and 21, although this is a minority opinion.

Historic growth in India's renewable energy


♦ Why in News?

Recently, according to the data of the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, India's total installed energy capacity is 484.8 gigawatts, out of which 242.8 gigawatts of energy is derived from non-fossil fuels.

Main Point

energy capacity target five years ahead of the target set under the Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) under the Paris Agreement.

- According to the Energy Institute's Statistical Review of Global Energy, India produced 2,030 terawatt-hours of electricity in the year 2024 and out of this, 240.5 terawatt-hours were obtained from renewable energy sources.
- India's 2030 target: India has set a target of 500 gigawatts of renewable energy-based energy production by 2030.

Kaziranga National Park - Assam

- **○** Why in News?
- Kaziranga National Park has emerged as a biodiversity hotspot for grassland birds.



- Main Point
- A total of 43 bird species were recorded in the grassland bird survey conducted in this park and these species also include rare and endangered birds such as-

- **Critically Endangered: Bengal Florican.**
- **Endangered:** Finn's Weaver, Swamp Grass Babbler.
- Vulnerable 6 species: Black-breasted Parrotbill, Marsh Babbler, Swamp Francolin, Jerdon's Babbler, Slender-billed Babbler, Bristled Grassbird.
- Successful breeding of Finn's Weaver has been confirmed in this park, which is an indicator of the healthy state of the grassland ecosystem of Kaziranga.
- The 1,174 sq km area of Kaziranga Park provides a rich habitat for birds.
- The bird diversity in the grasslands here is considered to be at par with states like Gujarat and Rajasthan.
- This survey is considered to be an important initiative towards bird conservation in Northeast India.

Kaziranga National Park:

- This park is known for the 'Big Five' (rhinoceros, tiger, elephant, Asiatic wild buffalo, eastern swamp deer).
- Almost the entire population of eastern swamp deer is found here.
- Kaziranga is located on the banks of the Brahmaputra River. This river provides nutrients to the park but also causes habitat loss due to erosion.

- **Executive Ministry:** Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- **Headquarters:** New Delhi.
- Function or Role: The National Medical Commission is the premier medical regulatory body of the country, regulating medical education, institutions, professionals and research, assisting the Government in policy making.
