Rajasthan

India's first drone-AI based artificial rain experiment: Ramgarh Dam, Jaipur

- **○** Why in News?
- For the first time in India, drones and artificial intelligence (AI) based cloud seeding technology is being used for artificial rain. This pilot project is being conducted in the Ramgarh Dam area in Jaipur.



Solution Service Serv

- It aims to revive the 129-year-old reservoir, which has been dry for the last two decades and has not been filled to its full capacity since 1981.
- This initiative has been started in joint collaboration between Indo-US technology company GenX AI and the Rajasthan government.

Facts for Prelims:

Artificial Rain

- Artificial rain is a technique through which rain is induced through scientific methods, especially when natural rainfall is not occurring or is very less. This is called cloud seeding.
- Some chemical elements are used in cloud seeding; Such as
 - Silver iodide,
 - o Potassium iodide,
 - Sodium chloride,
 - Solid CO2 (dry ice)
- Their particles go into the clouds and combine with water droplets, due to which they become heavy and start falling down in the form of rain.

Purpose:

- For rain in dry areas,
- For agricultural assistance,
- To increase the water level in reservoirs and dams,
- To reduce air pollution (eg: Beijing and Delhi) etc.

Rajasthan topped the solar energy investment plans

○ Why in News?

According to the recently released 'Projects Today' report, in the first quarter (April-June) of the financial year 2025-26, Rajasthan topped the solar energy investment plans, leaving behind Maharashtra and Gujarat, as compared to the fourth quarter of the year 2024-25.



Solution Service Serv

- According to the report, a total investment of ₹ 2.69 lakh crore was registered in Rajasthan through 419 new projects. Of this, about 86 percent investment has been made in the solar and wind energy sector.
- In the first quarter (June-July), 130 solar and wind projects attracted an investment of ₹ 2.33 lakh crore.

Facts for Prelims:

- Rajasthan, with solar radiation intensity of 6-7 kWh/sqm/day and more than 325 solar days annually, has a huge potential for solar energy, with an estimated potential of 142 GW according to the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy.
- The main objective of Rajasthan's Integrated Clean Energy Policy, 2024 is to contribute to achieving the national target of 500 GW of renewable energy by the year 2030.
- Under this policy, a target has been set to install 115 GW of renewable energy generation and 10 GW of energy storage capacity by the year 2029-30. In this, solar energy, wind energy, biomass and green hydrogen will be promoted.
- Rajasthan Solar Park Development Company Limited (RRECL) has been set up to manage and develop the infrastructure of renewable energy/solar parks.
- The 2,245 megawatt (MW) solar park at Bhadla, Jodhpur has been developed in four phases; the first phase of which has been developed by Rajasthan Renewable Energy Corporation Limited (RRECL) in-house and the second, third and fourth phases have been developed under the Solar Park Scheme of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy.

■ Olympian Anantjit Singh Naruka won India's first gold medal (senior category) in the men's skeet event at the 16th Asian Shooting Championship 2025 being held in Shymkent, Kazakhstan.

- In the final match, Naruka defeated former Asian Games champion Mansoor Al-Rashidi (Kuwait) 57-56.
- This was Naruka's first individual gold medal in the Asian Championship, while it was his fifth medal overall in the Asian Championship.
- It is noteworthy that Anantjit Singh Naruka represented India at the Paris 2024 Olympics.
- Girish Gupta (Rajasthan): Girish Gupta won the second gold medal in the junior category of the championship. The pair of Girish and Gambarya Gowda defeated Iran 16-14 to win the gold medal in the mixed air pistol event. This is Girish's third medal in this championship. Earlier, he had won gold in the individual event and silver in the team event.



Online Gaming Promotion and Regulation Bill 2025

- **○** Why in News?
- On August 20, 2025, the Online Gaming Promotion and Regulation Bill 2025 was passed in the Lok Sabha.

Solution Key Points:

- The Bill encourages e-sports and online social games, while banning harmful online money gaming services.
- Introduced: By Electronics and Information Technology Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw.
- Objective: To protect individuals, especially youth and vulnerable sections, from the adverse effects of such games.

Provisions:

- The Bill has three sections: e-sports, online social games and online money games.
- Online Gaming Authority: Provisions for the appointment of an Online Gaming Authority for coordinated policy support, strategic development and regulatory oversight of the sector.
- The proposed law provides for the establishment of a statutory regulatory authority with the power to determine money games and non-money games.

Punishment Provisions:

- Any person providing online money gaming services in violation of the law may face imprisonment of up to 3 years or fine of up to ₹1 crore, or both.
- Those advertising such services may face imprisonment of up to 2 years and/or fine of up to ₹50 lakh. Banks and financial institutions facilitating transactions for real money games will also be liable for penalties including imprisonment of up to 3 years or fine of up to ₹1 crore.
- Repeat offenders are liable for severe punishment. This includes imprisonment of three to 5 years and fine of up to Rs 2 crore.
- The Bill does not consider those playing online money games as criminals but treats them as victims.

Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi's visit to India

- **○** Why in News?
- China's Foreign Minister and Communist Party Politburo member Wang Yi visited India for two days, which also includes the 24th round of special delegation level talks on India-China border dispute.

Results of the talks:

- Both countries have agreed to resume border trade through Lipulekh Pass,
 Shipki La Pass and Nathu La Pass.
- 2. Agreement was reached on starting direct flights between India and China and signing a new Air Services Agreement.

- 3. Both countries agreed on forming a border management working group, maintaining peace on the border and starting the process of de-escalation.
- 4. The Prime Minister will attend the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) summit in Tianjin, China from August 31 to September. 5. China will support India hosting BRICS in 2026 and India will support China hosting BRICS in 2027.
- 6. China holds 70% of the rare earth minerals. These are important for drones, battery storage, defence, satellite/space technology. India imports 80% of its rare earth magnets from China.
- 7. India will get fertilisers, rare earth minerals, tunnel boring machines and emergency hydrological information from China.

- **○** Why in News?
- On 20 Asagat, 2025, Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology, Earth Sciences, Dr. Jitendra Singh provided information regarding the National Deep Ocean Mission in the Lok Sabha.

- Launch: India's Deep Ocean Mission was launched on 7 September 2021 by the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES).
- Objective: To develop technologies for exploration and sustainable use of living and non-living wealth of the deep sea.
- Duration and Outlay: This mission is designed as a national project for the development of Blue Economy, with a total investment of ₹4077 crore over five years.

Components of the Mission

- Technological innovations for exploration and conservation of deep-sea biodiversity: Its main objective is to conduct research on bio-discovery of deep-sea flora, fauna and microorganisms as well as sustainable use of deep-sea biological resources.
- Deep Ocean Survey and Exploration: This initiative focuses on identifying multi-metallic hydrothermal sulphide sites along the mid-ocean ridges of the Indian Ocean and supports exploration of deep-sea resources under the Blue Economy.
- Energy and Freshwater from the Ocean: This concept proposal proposes studies and engineering design for an offshore ocean thermal energy conversion (OTEC) powered desalination plant.
- Advanced Marine Station for Ocean Biology: This component focuses on building talent and innovation in ocean biology and engineering and converting research into industrial products through on-site incubators.

Other Important Points:

- India has 9 coastal states and 1382 islands forming a coastline of 7517 km.
- Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development: The United Nations has named the decade 2021-2030 as the 'Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development' to provide solutions to global challenges like climate change.

Project Samudrayaan:

- Objective: To undertake its first component of deep ocean exploration through manned submersible.
- Matsya 6000: A self-propelled manned submersible, capable of carrying three persons to depths up to 6,000 metres below the sea surface.



- Akshay Urja Diwas was started in 2004 to encourage the development and use of renewable energy in India.
- The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has reported robust progress in India's clean energy sector for the Financial Year 2024–25.
- With a record annual capacity addition of 29.52 GW, the total installed renewable energy (RE) capacity in the country has reached 220.10 GW as of 31st March 2025, up from 198.75 GW in the previous fiscal.
- This performance reflects India's steady advancement towards the target of achieving 500 GW of non-fossil fuel-based capacity by 2030, as part of its commitments under the 'Panchamrit' goals set by Prime Minister.
- The day also marks the birth anniversary of former Prime Minister of India Rajiv Gandhi, who played a key role in promoting and supporting sustainable development and renewable energy initiatives.
- The word 'Akshaya' is derived from Sanskrit, meaning "eternal" or "indestructible". Akshaya Urja means "eternal energy", synonymous with renewable energy, symbolizing the endless and sustainable nature of such energy sources.



India's performance so far:

■ So far in the Under-20 World Wrestling Championship 2025, Indian wrestlers have won three medals including one gold and two silver.

India's previous performance:

■ In the World Championship held in Spain in the year 2024, India won seven medals, including one gold, one silver and five bronze. Jyoti Berwal won the only gold medal in the women's 76 kg weight category.

- ♦ The pilgrimage remained completely zero-landfill and plastic-free due to the efforts of the Jammu and Kashmir administration and Shri Amarnath Shrine Board (SASB).
- ♦ About 11.67 metric tonnes of waste was generated daily during the yatra, which was completely composted and recycled. For this, twin-bin stations, garbage collection vehicles, mobile toilets and Safai Mitras were deployed.

2. India's GDP growth rate: RBI



- **♦** According to the report released by the RBI Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) on August 19, 2025, India's GDP growth rate is estimated to be 6.7 percent in the first quarter of FY 2026, up from 6.5 percent.
- ♦ According to ICRA, the Services GVA growth rate may reach 8.3% in the first quarter of FY26, up from 7.3% in the fourth quarter of FY25.

Uttarakhand Minority Education Bill 2025



♦ Passed: On August 20, 2025, the Uttarakhand Assembly passed the Uttarakhand Minority Educational Institutions Act 2025.

Provisions:

- 1. The status of minority educational institution in the state was available only to the Muslim community, but under this new bill, Sikh, Jain, Christian, Buddhist and Parsi communities will also get this facility.
- 2. From July 1, 2026, the Madrasa Board will be dissolved and Uttarakhand Minority Education Authority will be formed in its place.
- 3. For recognition, it will be mandatory for the institutions to be registered under the Act and have property in their name.
