### Rajasthan Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS)

- **♦** Why in News?
- Recently, the Rajasthan government announced the introduction of the 'Rajasthan Institute of Medical Sciences, Jaipur Bill 2025' in the Legislative Assembly to establish Rajasthan Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS) on the lines of AIIMS, New Delhi.



- **○** Key Points:
- Announcement: Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS) will be upgraded to establish RIMS in Jaipur, in respect of which an announcement was made in the state budget for the year 2024-25.
- It is also proposed to merge the State Cancer Institute, Jaipur with RIMS.
- Type of Institute: RIMS will function as an autonomous institute and university where degrees, diplomas and other academic recognitions can be granted under the National Medical Commission Act, 2019.

**Date: 26 August, 2025** 



- Facilities: RIMS will have super speciality facilities like cardiology, neurology, gastroenterology, neurosurgery, urology, plastic surgery, endocrinology, nephrology, CTVS and transplant unit.
- Structure: The Chief Secretary of the state will be the chairman of RIMS and a director will be appointed on deputation. Also, a governing body will be formed which will include experts from reputed national institutes like AIIMS New Delhi, PGI Chandigarh and IIM.
- Budget provision: RIMS will function as an autonomous institute with a dedicated fund. The state government has proposed to spend ₹100 crore for the creation of infrastructure of RIMS. A budget provision of Rs 5 crore per year has been made for other expenses, which can be increased as per requirement.

■ The award was presented by the Lieutenant Governor of Jammu and Kashmir Manoj Sinha at a ceremony held in Srinagar.



- Raj Kisan Sathi is an innovative single window online integrated portal developed by the Government of Rajasthan, launched to realize the vision of "Ease of Doing Farming" on the lines of "Ease of Doing Business".
- This portal provides more than 120 online modules of agriculture and allied departments through a completely paperless and faceless ecosystem.

  Rajasthan is the first state in the country to develop such an integrated structure.
- Raj Kisan Sathi provides easy access to direct benefit transfer schemes, licensing services, quality control, digital advice and other services to farmers. So far, more than 73 lakh farmers have joined this initiative.
- Raj Kisan Sathi has received several prestigious awards, including the National e-Governance Award 2023-24 (Silver Category), Skoch Awards, and Prime Minister's Outstanding Public Administration Award (Finalist).

#### Chinnewala Tibba Block Gas Field: Jaisalmer

#### **○** Why in News?

As per Rajasthan Economic Review 2024 - 25, a petroleum mining lease was granted to ONGCL for production of natural gas in Chinnewala Tibba, Jaisalmer Basin.



In this sequence, recently ONGC has started production of 1 lakh cubic meter of gas from Chinnewala Tibba block.

#### **Solution Service Serv**

- Currently, natural gas production from Jaisalmer is around 0.81 to 0.87 million standard cubic meters (mmscm) per day. Total natural gas production in Rajasthan is between 3.50 to 3.70 mmscm per day.
- Rajasthan has significant resource potential of hydrocarbons under 4 petroleum basins. Due to hydrocarbon prospects, 3 petroleum basins of Rajasthan have been upgraded to Category-I, this category includes areas like Mumbai Offshore, Krishna-Godavari, Assam Shelf, Convery, Combe and Assam Akran Fold Belt.
- These 4 basins are located in 14 districts of the state namely, Barmer, Jaisalmer, Bikaner, Sri Ganganagar, Hanumangarh, Jalore, Jodhpur, Kota, Jhalawar, Baran, Bundi, Bhilwara, Churu and Chittaurgarh, covering an area of 1,50,000 sq km.
- Rajasthan has immense potential for investment in upstream, midstream and downstream hydrocarbon sector.

### Fossils in Megha village of Jaisalmer

#### **○** Why in News?

■ Recently, fossils from before the Jurassic period have been discovered in Megha village of Jaisalmer district. The species to which this fossil belongs has become extinct 200 million years ago.

- This fossil has been discovered by the team of Professor V.S. Parihar of Jai Narayan Vyas University.
- This fossil discovered is a 200 million year old Phytosaur, which resembled a crocodile in shape and structure. This creature lived around water.
- This is the first time such a fossil has been found in India, although its official confirmation will be possible only after a study by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) and the Geological Survey of India (GSI).

■ It is known that even before this, remains of dinosaurs have been found in Jaisalmer. Remains of dinosaurs have been found in Akal and Baiya villages here.

#### Akal Wood Fossil Park, Jaisalmer

- One of the 12 geo-heritage sites identified in Rajasthan by the Geological Survey of India (GSI), the Akal Wood Fossil Park is located in Jaisalmer district.
- The wood fossils belong to a rich flora that existed along the seashore in a warm and humid climate around 180 million years ago.
- Spread over 21 hectares, the fossil park consists of Petrophilum, Ptilophylum, Aquisetitis species and dicotyledonous wood and gastropod shells belonging to the Lower Jurassic period.







**History:** 

- In 1971, Congress passed a resolution introduced by Representative Bella Abzug (Democrat-New York) in 1973 and designated 26 August as "Women's Equality Day".
- The date was chosen to commemorate the ratification of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution in 1920, which gave women the right to vote.


- ♦ Event: To be held from August 29 to September 7, 2025 at Rajgir Hockey Stadium, Bihar.





#### Discovery of new organic magnet



- **◆ Discovery:** Scientists have discovered a new type of organic magnet.
- **◆ Discoverer:** By scientists at the Institute for Materials of Tohoku University.
- **Name:** Scientists have placed it in a new category called ultramagnet.
- ♦ Ultramagnet: It is an organic magnet, which is made of carbon-based molecules and the electrons in the ultramagnet are aligned in a different way, due to which it exhibits special properties.
- **◆ Feature:** It is different from traditional ferromagnets (substances that form magnets) or antiferromagnets (substances that eliminate magnetism) and has the ability to bend light.
- **♦ Use:** Optical devices and quantum computing.
