

Rajasthan Coaching Centre (Control and Regulation) Bill, 2025


Why in News?

On September 03, 2025, the 'Rajasthan Coaching Center (Control and Regulation) Bill, 2025' was passed by voice vote in the Assembly.



Key Points:

- The formation of this bill as an Act will encourage coaching institutes that follow the rules. Also, no coaching institute will be able to operate without state registration.
- In the bill, the number of students for registration of coaching institutes has been increased from a minimum of 50 to 100 so that small and unorganized coaching centers can provide their services to the students.





- The penalty for the first irregularity by the coaching institute has been reduced from ₹ 2,00,000 to ₹ 50,000 and for the second irregularity, the penalty has been reduced from ₹ 5,00,000 to ₹ 2,00,000. Even after this, if the violation continues, a provision has been made to cancel the registration.
- Provisions have been made in the bill to prevent suicidal tendencies among students and to remove mental stress.
- For stress-free study of students, it will be mandatory to appoint a psychological counsellor in every coaching institute and organize stress management sessions.

Other Important Points:

Rajasthan Coaching Center Control and Regulation Authority:

- The bill provides for the establishment of a coaching authority to control all coaching institutes at the state level.
- Chairman: Secretary in-charge of Higher Education Department.
- **Members:** Secretaries of School Education Department, Technical Education Department, Medical Education, IG, College Education Commissioner, DLB Director, Psychologist, Nominated Secretary from Finance Department, 2 representatives from Coaching Centre and 2 members from Parent Committee.
- **Member Secretary:** Joint Secretary of Higher Education Department.
- A committee will be formed under the chairmanship of the Collector at the district level.

Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (Amendment) Bill, 2025



■ On September 3, 2025, the 'Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (Amendment) Bill, 2025' was passed by voice vote in the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly.



Key Points:

- Announcement: Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS) will be upgraded to RIMS in Jaipur, in respect of which an announcement was made in the state budget for the year 2024-25. It is also proposed to incorporate the State Cancer Institute, Jaipur in RIMS.
- Type of Institute: RIMS will function as an autonomous institute and university where degrees, diplomas and other academic recognitions can be granted under the National Medical Commission Act, 2019.
- Facilities: RIMS will have super specialty facilities like cardiology, neurology, gastroenterology, neurosurgery, urology, plastic surgery, endocrinology, nephrology, CTVS and transplant unit.
- Structure: The Chief Secretary of the state will be the chairman of RIMS and the director will be appointed on deputation. Also, a governing body will be formed, which will include experts from prestigious national institutions like AIIMS New Delhi, PGI Chandigarh and IIM.
- Budget provision: RIMS will function as an autonomous institute, which will have a dedicated fund. The state government has proposed to spend ₹100 crore for the construction of infrastructure of RIMS. A budget provision of ₹ 5 crore per year has been allocated for other expenses, which can be increased as per requirement.

Facts for Prelims:

- Heal in Rajasthan Policy-2025: With the aim of making Rajasthan a major medical tourism hub along with world-class healthcare services and infrastructure, the Rajasthan Cabinet approved the draft Medical Value Travel Policy (Heal in Rajasthan Policy) 2025. This policy will establish Rajasthan as an accessible, affordable and reliable Medical Value Travel (MVT) destination.
- Right to Healthcare Act, 2023: The Right to Healthcare Act, 2023 was passed by the Rajasthan Government with the aim of providing universal health access to all the residents of Rajasthan. This Act will create a more accessible, affordable and accountable health ecosystem in Rajasthan.
- Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA): As a part of the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has introduced the ABHA ID, a 14-digit unique number, with the main objective of creating a centralized repository for the health records of citizens. Rajasthan ranks second in the whole country in making ABHA ID.

Why in News?

Key Points:

- Venue: B.M. Birla Convention Center, Jaipur.
- Collaboration: In collaboration with various reputed organizations of the hospitality and tourism sector.
- According to the data of the year 2023-24, Rajasthan ranks fifth in the choice of domestic and foreign tourists, where the state's share in both categories is 7 to 8 percent.
- Principal Secretary of Rajasthan Tourism Department: Rajesh Yadav.
- Commissioner of Rajasthan Tourism Department: Rukmani Riyar.

- With the aim of promoting tourism in Rajasthan, the State Tourism Directorate was established in the year 1955 and Rajasthan Tourism Development Corporation Limited (RTDC) in the year 1978.

Rajasthan Tourism Unit Policy (RTUP) – 2024

- Launch: 4 December, 2024
- Objective: To increase the benefits payable to investors and entrepreneurs associated with Rajasthan tourism and to provide employment and entrepreneurship opportunities through encouraging the establishment of new tourism units in the private sector.
- This policy mainly focuses on providing exemptions for heritage hotels and properties, taking advantage of heritage properties available in the private sector. Additionally, the licensing process for operating hotels, restaurants and other tourism-related establishments has been streamlined in the tourism policy.

Key Points:


Details of Vikram 3201

Development:

- ISRO's Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) and Semiconductor Laboratory (SCL), Chandigarh developed it along with KALPANA 3201.
- It is an improved version of the 16 bit VIKRAM1601, which has been in use in ISRO's launch vehicle avionics since 2009.

Technical Features:

- **Temperature Tolerance: From 55°C to 125°C.**
- Space Testing: Initial testing was successful in SpaDeX mission (PSLV C60).
- Instruction Set: Custom architecture, specifically for the Ada programming language.
- Competency: Able to handle floating point calculations and complex processes.
- Objective: To enable India's self-reliance in navigation, guidance and control systems of launch vehicles.

GST Council: Two-rate tax slabs approved



The Government of India, through the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council, has approved two-rate tax slabs, which will be effective from 22 September 2025. Under this scheme, the tax slabs of 5% and 18% have



been retained, while a rate of 40% has been fixed on certain special goods.



Key Points:

Special Rate:

40% Rate: This rate will apply to tobacco products, aerated water, caffeinated beverages, large vehicles, helicopters, yachts, etc.

Objective:

The move is aimed at simplifying GST compliance, reducing costs and promoting domestic consumption.

What is GST Council?

Constitutional Body:

The GST Council was added to the Constitution in 2016 by Article 279A under the 101st Constitutional Amendment Act, and came into force in 2017.

Composition as per Constitution:

As per Article 279A(1), the GST Council is constituted by the President within 60 days of the commencement of the 101th Constitutional Ammendment.





Members:

- Chairman Union Finance Minister
- **Members** Union Minister of State in charge of Revenue or Finance
- **Other Members** Minister nominated by each State Government or Minister in charge of Finance/Taxation

Decision Making Process:

The GST Council takes decisions on a consensus-based approach. The Council meets from time to time, especially to discuss and decide on important issues related to GST.

Ouorum:

The Constitution states that one-third of the total number of members of the Council shall constitute a quorum.

Voting Structure:

- The decision of the GST Council shall be taken by a majority of at least threefourths of the weighted votes of the members present and voting:
- One-third of the total votes cast to the Centre
- Two-thirds of the total votes cast to the States
- This system promotes the spirit of inclusive and cooperative federalism.

Recommendations:

The recommendations of the GST Council are not binding on the state legislature. The Supreme Court had held in the 2022 Mohit Minerals case that both the Centre and the states can legislate on GST, and the Council's recommendations are only a result of "collaborative negotiations between the Union and the States".

- One-fourth of all mammal species and 40% of amphibian species are facing serious extinction threats.



Key Points:
