

#### **Key Points:**

- It is known that the auction of Bhukhiya-Jagpura mining was held on May 15, 2024, whose documentary is 9.4026 sq km. is in the domain.
- According to geologists, this area has a reserve of 113.52 million tonnes of gold stones in 940.26 mines.



#### Why in News?

■ Recently 'Green India Campaign' was launched by Dr. Arun Chaturvedi, Chairman, Rajasthan State Finance Commission.



#### **Key Points:**

- This campaign is being conducted by 'Solar Organization India' to promote Pradhan Mantri Surya Ghar Yojana.
- Under this campaign, the organization will organize 'Green India Exhibition' in Jodhpur from 16 to 18 November 2025 and in Jaipur from 21 to 23 January 2026.

#### **Facts for Prelims:**

Pradhan Mantri Surya Ghar Yojana:

- Launched on: 13 February 2024 by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- Objective: To provide free electricity to homes by facilitating the installation of rooftop solar panels.

Target: To supply Electricity by solar Panels to one crore homes by March 2027.

#### **Subsidy Details:**

Average Monthly Electricity Consumption (Units)	Suitable Rooftop Solar Plant Capacity	Subsidy Assistance

150–300	2–3 kW	₹60,000 to ₹78,000

#### **Ideal Solar Village:**

- Under the 'Ideal Solar Village' component of Pradhan Mantri Surya Ghar Yojana, the focus is primarily on setting up one ideal solar village in each district across India.
- The initiative aims to promote the adoption of solar energy and empower rural communities to achieve energy self-sufficiency.
- An allocation of ₹800 crore has been set aside for this component, out of which ₹1 crore will be provided to each selected ideal solar village.

#### Shahar Chalo Abhiyan (September 15 to October 2, 2025) 4.

- The Rajasthan government will conduct a state-wide 'Shahar Chalo Abhiyan' from September 15 to October 2, 2025.
- Under this campaign, public welfare works like improvement of sanitation system in urban bodies, installation of new street lights, catching stray animals, birth-death certificates, maintenance and beautification of public places, road repairs will be done.

#### 5. Gaon Chalo Abhiyan (from 18 September, 2025)

- The Rajasthan government will conduct the 'Gaon Chalo Abhiyan' three days a week across the state from September 18, 2025, in which easy access to government services will be ensured to the villagers.
- The state government will run this campaign in two gram panchayats of every Panchayat Samiti from September 18 and will run three days a week.
- Under this campaign, applications for government schemes, health camps, repair work of schools, distribution of seeds and mini pests among farmers etc. type of tasks will be parformed.

#### Country in news: Afghanistan

#### Why in News?

Recently, a 6.0 magnitude earthquake struck Afghanistan's eastern provinces of Nangarhar and Kunar, killing nearly 1500 people and injuring more than 4000.









#### **Key Points:**

**■ Epicenter: 27** km east of Jalalabad on the Pakistan border.

**Geographical Location:** 

- Afghanistan is a landlocked country located at the junction of Central Asia and South Asia.
- Neighbouring Countries: Shares its border with India (through Pakistan Occupied Kashmir) in the east, Pakistan in the south, Iran in the west, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan in the north, Tajikistan in the north-east and China (through the Wakhan Corridor) in the north-east.

**Major Mountains and Plateaus:** 

- Hindu Kush Mountains: The main mountain range of the country, which extends from north-east to south-west. This mountain range has a significant impact on the climate and transportation here.
- Highest Peak of Afghanistan: Noshaq (7,492 m)
- Paropamisus Mountains: Western extension of Hindu Kush, extending towards Iran.

**Major Rivers:** 

- 1. Amu Darya: River originating from Pamir glaciers, forms the border in the north.
- 2. Hari River: Originates from Baba Mountain, passes near Herat and goes towards Iran.
- 3. Helmand River: Originates from Baba Mountain and flows towards southwest and finally ends in the Sistan Basin.
- 4. Kabul River: Originates from the plateaus of eastern Afghanistan and meets the Indus River in Pakistan.

Wakhan Corridor: A narrow high plateau region that stretches between China, Pakistan and Tajikistan, once known as the 'most isolated corner of the world'. It is important from historical and strategic point of view.




**Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) – Amnesty Scheme 2025** 



#### Why in News?

Amnesty Scheme 2025 just got approved in the 196th Corporation Meeting of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC).






#### **Key Points:**

Objective: To reduce the backlog of court cases and promote compliance under the ESI Act through settlement of legal disputes.

#### **Scheme Period:**

- **Applicable:** From 01 October 2025 to 30 September 2026.
- The scheme will provide employers a structured mechanism of dispute resolution outside of court cases.





#### **Legal and Administrative Provisions:**

- As on 31 March 2025, about 27,000 cases were pending in various courts.
- **■** Features for employers under the scheme are:
  - Settlement of ad-hoc assessment by paying actual contribution and interest
     no additional compensation.
  - 2. Cases already paid will be withdrawn, provided 10% of the disputed compensation is paid.
  - 3. Cases filed due to non-submission of records or delay in payment by ESIC, which are complied with later, will be withdrawn with the permission of the court.
  - 4. Court cases filed up to 31.03.2025 will become eligible under this scheme.
- Regional Directors and Sub-Regional Officers have the authority to process withdrawals in this period.

#### Significance:

- Earlier, due to limited appeal provision and lack of withdrawal powers, litigation took a long time even after compliance.
- Amnesty 2025 removes these shortcomings and provides a genuine and benevolent dispute resolution route for employers.
- It will support the Government's 'Ease of Doing Business' objectives.

■ The two-week campaign as part of the Government of India's Swachh Bharat Mission covered cleanliness, awareness and sustainability initiatives involving officials of MHI, autonomous bodies and Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs).

#### **National Nutrition Week 2025**

- **₩** Why in News?
- Event: National Nutrition Week 2025 will be organized from September 1 to 7, 2025.
- Theme: "Eat Right for a Better Life".





#### **Key Points:**

#### **Objective:**

- 1. To spread awareness about adopting a balanced diet and conscious eating habits.
- 2. To focus on prevention of malnutrition and lifestyle diseases.
- This initiative is being jointly run by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Ministry of Women and Child Development.





The event, which is linked with national programs like Poshan Abhiyaan, aims to make people aware of the importance of nutrition.

#### **Background:**

- It was first launched in 1982 by the Food and Nutrition Board of the Ministry of Women and Child Development.
- India is facing three nutrition challenges majorly:
  - i. Malnutrition in children and mothers.
  - ii. Micronutrient deficiencies (such as anemia).
  - iii. Diet-borne diseases (such as obesity, diabetes and hypertension).

#### **Related Government Programmes:**

- Poshan Abhiyaan (National Nutrition Mission): Focuses on eliminating malnutrition, stunting, anaemia and low birth-weight.
- Mid-day Meal Scheme (PM-POSHAN): Focuses on providing nutritious meals to school children.
- Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS): Focuses on providing additional nutrition to children below six years of age and pregnant/lactating women.
- Anganwadi Centres: For nutritional counselling and fortified distribution.
