

5. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Rajasthan Ayurveda University, Jodhpur

- Recently, Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Rajasthan Ayurveda University, Jodhpur signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Association of Ayurveda Academy, Community Interest Company (UK) and Indo-German Young Leaders Forum for a Responsible Future eV (Germany).

Global Peace Index – 2025

Why in News?

Recently, the 19th edition of the Global Peace Index was released by the international think-tank 'Institute for Economics and Peace (IEP)'.



- India ranked 115th in this index with a score of 2.229. Iceland has remained the most peaceful country in the world since 2008.
- This index was first released by the international think-tank Institute for Economics and Peace (IEP) in May, 2009, since then it is released annually.



25th Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Summit, 2025

Why in News?

■ From August 31 to September 1, 2025, the Indian Prime Minister attended the 25th meeting of the Council of Heads of State of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) held in Tianjin, China. The summit discussed SCO development strategy, reform of global governance, counter-terrorism, peace and security, economic and financial cooperation and sustainable development.



- **Event:** Held from August 31 to September 1, 2025 in Tianjin, China.
- Chaired by: Chinese President Xi Jinping.
- Key Documents Signed: A total of 24 important documents were signed, including the Tianjin Declaration, Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Development Strategy until 2035, Statement of the Council of Heads of State of the SCO in connection with the 80th anniversary of the end of World War II and the formation of the United Nations, etc.

Declarations and Resolutions: Tianjin Declaration

Topic	Description
Development Strategy (2026–2035)	Outlines the long-term priorities and direction for the development of the SCO.
Cooperation Program (2026–2030)	Aims to counter extremist ideology, terrorism, and radicalism within the SCO region.
SCO Dialogue Partner & Observer Status	Laos granted SCO Dialogue Partner status; Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) granted Observer status.
Cholpon-Ata City	Cholpon-Ata (Kyrgyzstan) designated as the "SCO Tourism and Cultural Capital" for 2025–2026.
Roadmap for SCO Energy Cooperation, 2030	Cooperative initiatives for meeting renewable energy needs.

Institutional Strengthening:

■ Agreement on Establishment of Four SCO Anti-Drug Centres: Agreements were signed among the SCO member states on establishment of four SCO Anti-Drug Centres and the Universal Centre for Combatting Challenges and Threats to the Security of States.

Objectives:

- **■** Combatting international organized crime.
- **■** Enhancing information and cyber security.
- Combatting security threats and challenges.
- SCO Development Bank: It was decided to establish the SCO Development Bank, which aims to promote infrastructure development, economic progress and social cooperation among member states.
- Cooperation Platforms: The summit announced initiatives to create new SCO platforms and centres in various fields.

Vocational and technical education for workforce development.

Structural Reforms and Expansion:

- Merger of Observer and Dialogue Partners: Observer States and Dialogue Partners were merged into a single category of SCO Partners.
- Laos Partner Status: SCO expanded to 27 countries (10 members and 17 partners).

Others:

- The 26th Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Summit, 2026 will be chaired by Kyrgyzstan on the theme "25 Years of SCO: Together for a Stable World, Development and Prosperity".
- "SCO Plus" Meeting: Following the Council of Heads of State, a "SCO Plus" meeting was held on the theme "Implementing Multilateralism, Ensuring Regional Security and Promoting Sustainable Development".

Other Important Points:

Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO)

- It is a Eurasian political, economic and security intergovernmental organisation established on 15 June 2001 in Shanghai (China).
- Founding Members: China, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russia, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan.

- India and Pakistan were included as full members of SCO during the Astana Summit in the year 2017.
- **Headquarters:** Beijing (China)
- **Observer Countries:** Afghanistan and Mongolia.
- Dialogue Partners: Azerbaijan, Armenia, Bahrain, Cambodia, Egypt, Kuwait, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Turkey and United Arab Emirates have the status of dialogue partners.
- Official language: Chinese and Russian.
- It is the largest regional organization in the world in terms of geographical area and population.
- Member countries: China, India, Iran, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Pakistan, Russia, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan and Belarus.

Objectives:

- To strengthen mutual relations between member countries.
- To promote cooperation in political affairs, trade, technical, cultural and educational fields as well as energy, transport, tourism and environmental protection.
- Resolving bilateral and multilateral issues through mutual dialogue.
- Protecting regional peace, security and stability.
- Maintaining a democratic, equitable, international political and economic order.

1. 'Bihar State Livelihood Fund Credit Cooperative Federation
Limited'







- Launched: On September 2, 2025, the Prime Minister launched the Bihar State Livelihood Fund Credit Cooperative Federation Limited.
- Objective: To provide easy access to funds at affordable interest rates to community members associated with Jeevika.
- Importance: Jeevika Nidhi has been created as an alternative financial system to reduce dependence on microfinance institutions and ensure the availability of large loan amounts on time at low interest rates so that dependence on microfinance institutions can be reduced and large loan amounts can be made available on time at low interest rates.
- Financial status: All registered cluster-level federations of Jeevika will become members of this institution. Both the Bihar government and the central government will contribute funds for the operation of this institution.
- On this occasion, the Prime Minister also transferred Rs 105 crore to the bank account of the institution.
- This system will work completely on a digital platform, ensuring direct and rapid transparent transfer of funds to the bank accounts of Jeevika Didis.

2. First Ground Handling Operations Company: Air India



- The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has granted security clearance to Air India SATS Airport Services Private Limited (AISATS) for the first time.
- With this, India has become the second country in the Asia-Pacific region after Malaysia to implement such a comprehensive framework in line with ICAO guidelines.
