New variety of Barley RD 3064

Why in News?

■ The new variety of barley RD 3064 is developed by the Rajasthan Agricultural Research Institute located in Durgapura (Jaipur).

Key Points:

- This variety of barley was presented in the annual meeting of the 64th All India Wheat and Barley Research Project held in Gwalior.
- This variety of barley has also been approved by the Central Variety Release Committee (CSC).
- Earlier, the Central Government has also issued the official gazette notification of the cumin variety 'Jodhpur Cumin-1 (JC-1)' which is developed by Jodhpur Agricultural University.
- Before starting the production of any variety, it is sent to the Ministry of Agriculture, and from there its production starts after the gazette notification.
- The new variety of barley will reduce dependence on foreign countries for barley used in beer, chocolate, baby food as well as health drinks.
- According to scientists, the maximum grain yield of this variety will be 91.67 quintals per hectare. The height of this plant will be 90 to 100 cm and the length of the ears will be approximately 9 to 10 cm.
- Climate change will also have less impact on this crop yield.

Millet Outlets in Rajasthan



■ So far 152 millet outlets have been opened by the cooperative department in Rajasthan, which is about four and a half times more than the target set.





- Millet: According to the United Nations, coarse grains or millets are those traditional grains, which are other than wheat and rice, such as jowar, bajra, ragi, maize, barley, kodo, foxtail and buckwheat etc. Coarse grains are also called 'nutritious grains' or 'Shri Ann'.
- Main products available at Millet outlets: Savan, Kutki, Kodo, Kangani, Choti Kangani, Roasted Jowar, Roasted Bajra, Ragi biscuits, Oats biscuits, cookies, Shri Ann Daliya, Ragi flakes etc.
- In compliance with the budget announcement of the state government, these millet outlets are being opened across the state to increase the reach of Shri Ann products to the general public, to popularize them and to create employment opportunities by selling millet products of self-help groups of cooperatives and Rajeevika.

■ Its main symptoms include shortness of breath, irregular heartbeat, chest pain, fatigue, dizziness and swelling in the legs and abdomen.

There are three main types of heart valve disease: stenosis, where the valve doesn't open properly; regurgitation, where blood leaks backward because the valve doesn't close properly; and atresia, where the valve doesn't develop properly from birth.

Mahavir Saini - Para Athletics Coach

Why in News?

■ Mahavir Saini has been appointed as the Chief Coach of the Indian team for the 'World Para Athletics Championships-2025' to be held from 25 September to 5 October 2025 at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium in New Delhi.



- India is hosting these games for the first time, in which players from 107 countries of the world will participate.
- A 73-member team from India is participating in this competition, which will include 54 men and 19 women.
- Paralympic medalists Sundar Singh
 Gurjar, Mahendra Singh Gurjar and Sandeep Chaudhary from Rajasthan
 are also part of the Indian team.

Facts for Prelims:

- Mahavir Prasad Saini was awarded the Dronacharya Award for the year 2023 by the President of India for his achievements in para athletics.
- He has trained many outstanding para athletics players including Sundar Singh Gurjar who won a bronze medal at the 2021 Paralympic Games held in Tokyo, Japan and Rakesh Bhaira who won a bronze medal at the 2023 Para-Asian Games held in Hangzhou, China.
- Mahaveer Saini has also been awarded the Guru Vashisht Award by the Rajasthan State Sports Council.







Sawai Mansingh Hospital ranks First in the country in **Emergency Services**

Why in News?

Recently, Sawai Mansingh Hospital, Jaipur got the highest rank in the country in the treatment of seriously injured people coming to the emergency in Neurotrauma and Trauma Center.

- SMS Hospital has been awarded the 'Best Institution Award 2025' by the Neurotrauma Society of India.
- After coming to the emergency services in SMS, the treatment of the injured starts in 6 to 8 minutes, which is better than the standards set by the National Health Mission (NHM).
- The trauma center of SMS Hospital, established in the year 2014, is the largest and most modern center in the country.

Nepal's new Prime Minister: Sushila Karki

Why in News?

Recently, a new interim government has been formed in Nepal under the leadership of former Chief Justice Sushila Karki.



- Selection: By Gen-Z leader, Nepali Army and President Ramchandra Paudel.
- Sushila Karki is the first woman Prime Minister to lead Nepal.
- Along with this, Karki was the first woman Chief Justice of Nepal from July, 2016 to June, 2017.
- President Ramchandra Paudel administered the oath of office to Karki at a ceremony held at the Presidential Palace in Kathmandu.

Disaster Risk Index (DRI)



Himachal Pradesh CM in a meeting with 16th Finance Commission stressed on revamping the Disaster Risk Index (DRI).



- It was prepared by the 15th Finance Commission.
- **Objective:** To bring fairness in resource allocation (fiscal federalism) and take into account disaster risks faced by the states.
- Coverage: It covers 14 hazards, 14 vulnerabilities and 2 exposures.
- Hazards: Earthquake, cyclone, flood, drought, etc.
- Vulnerables: Rural/Urban poor, children and women are most vulnerable, most.
- **Exposures:** It considers two parameters namely population and GDP.



Isobutanol blends with Diesel

Why in News?

■ India is exploring the possibility of blending isobutanol with diesel after failed ethanol-diesel trials.



- Isobutanol: It is a four-carbon alcohol (C₄H₁₀O), which is flammable, colourless and traditionally used as a solvent in the paint, coating and chemical industries.
- It is produced from both petrochemical processes and fermentation of biomass.





Advantages over Ethanol

- **■** Higher energy density than ethanol (closer to diesel).
- It has a lower hygroscopicity (it absorbs less water than ethanol), reducing the risk of corrosion in engines and pipelines.
- Isobutanol blend Trials: The Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) is testing a 10% isobutanol-diesel blend.
- Isobutanol is also being explored as an independent fuel and as compressed natural gas (CNG)-isobutanol flex-fuel options for tractors and agrimachinery.

Benefits:

- Promotes a cleaner alternative to fossil fuels.
- **■** Promotes energy security.
- It supports the energy transition and farmer income support goals of India's National Biofuel Policy (2018).

AdFalciVax Vaccine



■ The Government of India has allowed private companies to manufacture the country's first indigenous multi-stage malaria vaccine AdFalciVax.



- Development by: Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR).
- Mode of Action: This vaccine targets Plasmodium falciparum (the most deadly malaria parasite species) at multiple stages.
- Features: It is a recombinant chimeric vaccine, in which antigens taken from different stages of the parasite have been combined into a single immunogen by recombinant DNA technology.
- Advantages: This vaccine provides two-stage protection, maintains immunity for a long time and can be produced at a low cost.



F404-IN20 Engine

Why in News?

Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) has been awarded the F404-IN20 engine by US company GE Aerospee. The third F404-IN20 engine has been received from GE Aerospace.



Key Points:

■ The supply of F404-IN20 engines is necessary to ensure timely delivery of Tejas Mk-1A aircraft.

F404-IN20 Engine:

- Type: It is an after-burning turbofan engine, specially designed for India's LCA Tejas Mk-1A fighter aircraft.
- Power: It generates a thrust of about 85 kilo Newton (kN), enabling Tejas to fly at high subsonic and supersonic speeds.

First AI-based weather forecasting program



■ Under the first AI-based weather forecasting program, for the first time, the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare used the power of AI for farmers to send AI-based monsoon forecasts for the year 2025 to about 3.8 crore farmers in 13 states through SMS (M-Kisan).

Kev Points:

India is using AI and machine learning to analyze data received from various sources.

Sources of forecasts used by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare; Two Open-Access Models:

- **Google's Neural GCM**
- **ECMWF's AIFS (Artificial Intelligence Forecasting Systems)** First AI-based weather forecasting program/India's major initiatives related to AI based forecasting:
- Weather Information Network and Data System (WINDS): The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare launched WINDS to generate hyper-local, long-term weather data.
- AI and Machine Learning Centre: The Ministry of Earth Sciences has set up the AI and Machine Learning Centre in Pune to improve weather forecasting, which provides real-time forecasts of rainfall and snowfall using Doppler radar data.
- AI-based Monsoon Forecasting Models: The DST Centre of Excellence in Climate Modelling (CECM) at IIT-Delhi has developed AI/ML-based models for monsoon forecasting using historical data and climate drivers such as El Niño and Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD).
- Mission Mausam: Launched by the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) with the aim of modernizing the Indian weather and climate forecasting systems in the year 2024.




NASA: Discovery of possible Bio-signatures on Mars

Why in News?

- NASA's Perseverance Rover discovered organic elements in the rocks of Neretva Vallis, a dried-up river on Mars.
- This is a possible sign of the existence of microbes/life on Mars billions of years ago.



- Discovery Announced: During NASA's press conference on September 10, 2025.
- **Published in:** Nature magazine.
- Discovery Location: Neretva Vallis, Jezero Crater (ancient river system)
- Rock structure: Bright Angel Formation, clay and clay-rich mudstones.
- Bio-signatures/Chemical signals: High concentrations of 'leopard-like spots' and 'poppy seeds' were discovered at the microscopic level, which include the following chemical elements-





- 1. Organic Carbon
- 2. Oxidized Iron Sulphide
- 3. Iron Phosphate
- Importance of Discovery: Scientists believe that billions of years ago, Mars had liquid water, a thick atmosphere and active geochemistry, which could have been conducive to life.

Other Important Points:

- NASA's Perseverance Mission: Perseverance is a Mars rover of NASA which was launched on July 30, 2020.
- Landing: It landed on February 18, 2021 in Jezero Crater, the site of an ancient lake and river delta.
- Purpose: Perseverance has collected more than 30 samples that will be returned to Earth by a future mission.
- Task: The rover is searching for fossils of microorganisms in rocks formed during Mars' warm, humid past.
- Timeline and Cost: The current estimated cost is \$11 billion, which could push the timeline from the early 2030s to the 2040s.

Ingenuity; NASA's Mars Helicopter:

- Perseverance also launched a small helicopter drone called 'Ingenuity'.
- Ingenuity explored the area around the rover until its 72nd and final flight on January 18, 2024.
- A microphone funded by the Planetary Society was launched on NASA's Mars Polar Lander, the world's first crowdfunded science instrument to fly to another planet, and Perseverance's microphone recorded sounds from Mars for the first time.

Why in News?

■ On September 12, 2025, the Indian Navy commissioned INS Aravali in Gurugram under the MAHASAGAR: Mutual and Holistic Advancement for Security and Growth Across Regions.




- During the commissioning ceremony, the Navy Chief was given a guard of honour by 50 soldiers.
- Named: Avichal which is derived from the Aravalli mountain range.
- **Function:** It will provide support to various information and communication centres of the Indian Navy.
- Motto: Inspired by 'Samudra Surakshayam: Sahayog' or 'Maritime Security through Collaboration'.

Other Important Points:

Aravalli Mountain Range:



- Extension: It extends from Gujarat to Delhi through Rajasthan, of which 80 percent (560 km) is located in Rajasthan and 20 percent is located in Haryana, Delhi and Gujarat.
- **Extension in Rajasthan:** From Sirohi to Khetri.





- Length and Width: 692 km and width is between 10 to 120 km
- **Division:** Northern, Central and Southern Aravalli.
- Highest Peak: Gurushikhar (Sirohi), whose height is 1,722 meters.
- It acts as an ecotone between the Thar Desert and the Gangetic plain.
- Aravalli Green Wall Project: To develop a 1,400 km long and 5 km wide green wall around the Aravalli mountain range.
- It is inspired by Africa's 'Great Green Wall'.


Acharva Vinoba Bhave (1895-1982)

- Participated in the Quit India Movement.
- Became the first satyagrahi in the Individual Satyagraha movement.
- Vinoba Bhave founded the Gram Seva Mandal in 1934 to organise village service.
- He is particularly known for the Bhoodan Movement (1951).
