Why in News?

- Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma launched the 'Heal in Rajasthan Policy – 2025' at the 'State Level Arogya Camp' organized at Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS), Jaipur on December 15, 2025.

Key Points:

- Note: The draft of the Medical Value Travel Policy (Heal in Rajasthan Policy) 2025 was approved by the Rajasthan Cabinet in July 2025, with the objective of making Rajasthan a leading medical tourism hub with world-class healthcare services and infrastructure.

Objectives of the Policy:

- To establish Rajasthan as an accessible, affordable, and reliable Medical Value Travel (MVT) destination.
- To promote economic growth, job creation, and global branding by integrating the health and tourism sectors.
- Under this policy, investors will be provided incentives under the Rajasthan Investment Promotion Scheme (RIPS), Rajasthan Industrial Development Policy, and Tourism Policy, and Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) and Viability Gap Funding (VGF) will also be utilized.

Benefits:

- It will ensure the development of a digital ecosystem associated with Medical Value Travel (MVT) along with quality healthcare services.
- Multi-specialty hospitals located in Rajasthan will be able to develop according to international standards.
- Traditional medical practices such as Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, and Siddha will be promoted.
- Under this policy, a dedicated MVT cell will be established, and MVT facility providers and service providers will be certified.
- The policy will promote advancements in telemedicine, biotechnology, and app-based diagnostics. Teleconsultation and multilingual helpline services will also be established.

Other Important Points:

- **Ferric Carboxymaltose Injection Campaign:** The 'Ferric Carboxymaltose Injection Campaign' has been launched in the state to free, pregnant women from anemia.

Why in News?

- The Union Cabinet has approved the auction policy for coal linkages (Coal SETU) for seamless, efficient and transparent utilization.

CoalSETU Window for Fair Access and Optimal Coal Utilisation



CABINET DECISION: 12-12-2025

- Cabinet approves the **Policy for Auction of Coal Linkage for Seamless, Efficient & Transparent Utilisation** by creation of new window "CoalSETU" in the NRS (Non-Regulated Sector) Linkage Auction Policy of 2016
- The new window aims to allocate **coal linkages on auction basis** on long-term for any **industrial use and export**
- Any **domestic buyer** requiring coal can participate in the **linkage auction**

Key Points:

Coal SETU Policy:

- **It creates a new auction window for coal under the 2016 Non-Regulated Sector Linkage Auction Policy.**
- **Objective:** To allow long-term allocation of coal linkages on an auction basis for any type of industrial use and export.
- **Exception:** Coking coal will not be offered under this window.
- **Participation:** Any domestic buyer requiring coal can participate in the linkage auction.
- **Traders are not allowed to bid under this window.**

- Ponduru Khadi from Srikakulam district of Andhra Pradesh has received Geographical Indication (GI) tag recognition.



Key Points:

Additional Information:

- Ponduru Khadi is a handwoven fabric primarily made from a short-staple, pest-resistant variety of cotton grown locally in the hilly regions.
- This cotton is chemical-free, promoting sustainable agriculture and the region's traditional eco-friendly production methods.

GI Tag

- A GI tag protects products associated with a specific geographical origin, guaranteeing their unique qualities and characteristics.
- In India, it is granted under the Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection) Act, 1999.



Pax Silica Initiative

Why in News?

- Pax Silica is a new critical minerals diversification initiative of the United States. India has been excluded from this initiative.



Key Points:

- **Members:** Japan, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Netherlands, United Kingdom, Israel, United Arab Emirates, Australia.
- **Objective:** To build a secure, prosperous, and innovative silicon supply chain. This will include everything from critical minerals and energy inputs to advanced manufacturing, semiconductors, AI infrastructure, and logistics.



Operation Thunder - 2025

Why in News?

- Thousands of live animals were seized under Operation Thunder – 2025.

Key Points:

- Implementing Agency:** It was coordinated by Interpol and the World Customs Organization with the support of the Interpol Consortium on Combating Wildlife and Forestry Crime.


MahaCrimeOS AI

- The report highlights the role of skill development and small enterprises as key drivers of job creation in the country.

Major Employment Trends:

- Employment growth has been primarily driven by an increase in self-employment, while the shift from low-skilled to high-skilled employment has been slow.

- Most small enterprises operate at a subsistence level with low capital, low productivity, and limited use of technology.
- Medium-skilled jobs, particularly in services, dominate employment growth, while low-skilled labor remains prevalent in manufacturing.
- India's vocational education and training system faces significant structural challenges.

These challenges include:

1. Underutilization of available seats.
2. Inadequate placements.
3. Vacant trainer positions.
4. Weak industry linkages.
5. The persistent perception of vocational education as a non-primary option.



Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel

Why in News?

- The Prime Minister paid tribute to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the Iron Man of India, on his 75th death anniversary (December 15, 1950).

Key Points:

Other related facts:

- **Born:** October 31, 1875
- First Deputy Prime Minister and Home Minister of independent India.
- Led various constitutional committees such as the Advisory Committee on Fundamental Rights, the Committee on Minorities and Tribal and Excluded Areas, and the Provincial Constitution Committee.
- **Bharat Ratna:** 1991, posthumously.

Contribution to India's freedom movement:

1. **Kheda Satyagraha:** 1917, Kheda district of Gujarat
2. **Non-Cooperation Movement:** 1920-22
3. **Bardoli Satyagraha, 1928:** Supported the famine-stricken local population.
4. **Civil Disobedience Movement, 1930-34:** Actively participated in the Salt Satyagraha.
5. **Quit India Movement, 1942:** He inspired protests and strikes, boycotts of tax payments, and the closure of civil services.

Other important points:

- Since 2014, National Unity Day is celebrated annually on October 31st to commemorate Sardar Patel's birth anniversary.
- The world's tallest statue, the Statue of Unity, was unveiled on October 31, 2018, in Kevadia, Gujarat, on the occasion of Sardar Patel's 143rd birth anniversary.
- Civil Services Day is celebrated on April 21st to commemorate the address given by Sardar Patel to the first batch of civil servants of independent India in 1947.

Emperor Perumbidugu Mutharaiyar II (Suvaran Maran)

Why in News?

- The President of India released a postage stamp in honor of Emperor Perumbidugu Mutharaiyar II.



Key Points:

- Epithet:** Shatrubhayankara (Terrifier of Enemies).
- Dynasty:** Belonged to the Mutharaiyar dynasty, who were vassals of the Pallavas.
- Region:** Ruled over parts of central Tamil Nadu.
- Period:** During 705 AD to 745 AD.
- Capital:** Tiruchirappalli.
- Cultural Patronage:** Patronized temple construction, Shaivite and other scholars, and Tamil culture.
