Venezuela's New President: Delcy Rodríguez



Why in News?

- Venezuelan President Nicolás Maduro has been detained in New York on drug-related charges under a US military operation.
- The Venezuelan Supreme Court has ordered Vice President Delcy Rodríguez to assume the role of acting/interim president.
- Delcy Rodríguez was sworn in on January 5, 2026.
- Recently, the Venezuelan government declared a state of emergency due to external interference, granting the president broad powers.



Key Points:

Delcy Rodríguez:

- Rodríguez served as Vice President since 2018 and oversaw Venezuela's oil-dependent economy and intelligence services.
- Delcy also served as Foreign Minister between 2014 and 2017.
- **Monroe Doctrine:** According to the US, Nicolás Maduro was detained based on the Monroe Doctrine.
- **Proclamation:** By James Monroe, the 5th President of the United States, on September 2, 1823.

- **Introduction:** The Monroe Doctrine is a principle of US foreign policy that asserts that the Western Hemisphere is the exclusive sphere of influence of the United States, and any external (especially European) intervention would be considered a hostile act against the US.
- In January 2026, following the detention of Nicolás Maduro by the US military, President Trump described the operation as a modern update of the Monroe Doctrine.

Other Important Points:

Venezuela:

- **Location:** A federal multi-party republic in South America.
- **Borders:** Its northern coastline borders the Caribbean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean. (Shares borders with Guyana, Brazil, and Colombia.)
- **Capital:** Caracas

Main Features:

1. **Guiana Highlands:** Ancient crystalline highlands located in the southeast, including tepuis and Angel Falls (the world's tallest waterfall).
2. **Lake Maracaibo:** A major oil-producing region.
3. **Llanos Plains:** Vast tropical plains located along the Orinoco River (important for livestock farming and hydrocarbon production).
4. **Andes Mountains:** Located in the northwest (Cordillera de Mérida), including Bolívar Peak.

Cryptocurrency and Turkmenistan



Why in News?

- Recently, Turkmenistan has legalized cryptocurrency mining and exchanges.



Key Points:

- Under the new law, crypto assets have been brought under the purview of civil law.
- Crypto exchanges are now required to obtain a license from the Central Bank.
- This law legalizes cryptocurrency mining and exchanges from January 2026.
- NOTE:** Cryptocurrency has not been given the status of legal tender/security.

Other Important Points:

- Turkmenistan's economy:** Highly dependent on exports.
- Turkmenistan holds the world's fourth-largest natural gas reserves.

Cryptocurrency:

- **Introduction:** A digital or virtual currency that uses cryptography for security.
- It is a decentralized currency, meaning it is not regulated or controlled by any government or institution.

Major Examples:

1. **Bitcoin (Invented: The first cryptocurrency invented by Satoshi Nakamoto in 2009)**
 2. **Ethereum (Decentralized open-source blockchain platform)**
 3. **Litecoin (LTC) (Open-source software and peer-to-peer cryptocurrency)**
 4. **Ripple (Based on a protocol for cross-border payments)**
- **Secure:** Transactions related to cryptocurrencies are recorded in a public digital ledger called a blockchain.

ENVIRONMENT & ECOLOGY

Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change: Year 2025 Review

Why in News?

- The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has detailed India's major achievements in environmental protection, climate action, and institutional reforms in its 2025 review.



Key Points:

1. **Forest Conservation and Green Cover:** According to FAO, 2025, India ranks 9th globally in terms of forest area.
 - India ranks 3rd globally in terms of annual net forest increase.
2. **Wildlife Conservation:** A new Madhav Tiger Reserve has been declared in Madhya Pradesh.
 - The 6th All India Tiger Estimation has been launched.
 - The number of elephant reserves has increased to 33 by 2025.

- **Number of Protected Areas - 1134**
 - **Number of Community Reserves - 309**
 - **Project Cheetah:** Under this project, the total number of cheetahs has reached 30.
 - **5 national-level projects have been launched** - Project Dolphin - Phase II, Sloth Bear, Gharial, Centre of Excellence for Human-Wildlife Conflict Management, and a project on tigers outside Tiger Reserves.
3. **Coastal, Wetland and Mangrove Conservation:** Under the MISHTI scheme, 4536 hectares of mangroves were restored in 2025.
- 11 new Ramsar sites have been added in 2025, bringing the total number of Ramsar sites in India to 96.
 - India has the highest number of Ramsar sites in Asia, and Udaipur and Indore have been designated as India's first Ramsar Wetland Cities.
 - 18 beaches have been certified as Blue Flag beaches by 2025-26.
4. **Climate Change:** Installed capacity from non-fossil fuels exceeded 50% in June 2025, five years ahead of the target (2030).
- The Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS) has been launched.
5. **Air Quality and Urban Environment:** A reduction in PM-10 levels was recorded in 103 cities.
- 75 projects were approved under the Nagar Van Yojana (Urban Forest Scheme) in 2025.

Suryastra Rocket System



Why in News?

- The Indian Army has signed an emergency procurement contract worth ₹293 crore with NIBE Limited in collaboration with Elbit Systems.
- This contract will include the Suryastra rocket system, a long-range universal launcher with a range of up to 300 km.



Key Points:

- **Introduction:** India's first indigenous universal multi-caliber long-range rocket launcher system.
- It is capable of surface-to-surface strikes with a range of 150 km.
- **Manufacturer:** NIBE Limited (India)
- **Assistance:** By Elbit Systems.
- **Basis:** Based on the Israeli PULS (Precise and Universal Launching System). (Under a technology cooperation agreement; July 2025)
- **Objective:** To enhance the Indian Army's deep strike and stand-off firepower.
- **Range:** 150 km to 300 km.
- **Significance:** Greater capability than Pinaka, increased deterrence, and enhanced joint strike capability.

Rice Production: India is the largest producer globally



Why in News?

- According to the Union Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, India has surpassed China to become the world's largest rice producer with a production of 150.18 million tonnes.




Key Points:

- **Global Ranking:**

Why in News?

- World Braille Day is celebrated every year on January 4 to commemorate the birthday of Louis Braille.




Key Points:

- **Braille Script in India:** Braille script arrived in India in 1887, although Indian Braille was accepted as the sole standard only in 1951.
- **Braille Script:** Braille is a tactile (touch-based) writing and reading system used by people who are blind or have low vision. It is based on a cell of six dots, arranged in two columns of three dots each. Different combinations of these raised dots represent letters, numbers, punctuation marks, and symbols, enabling users to read through touch.

Accessible India Campaign:

- **Launched:** 2015

- Enacted under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

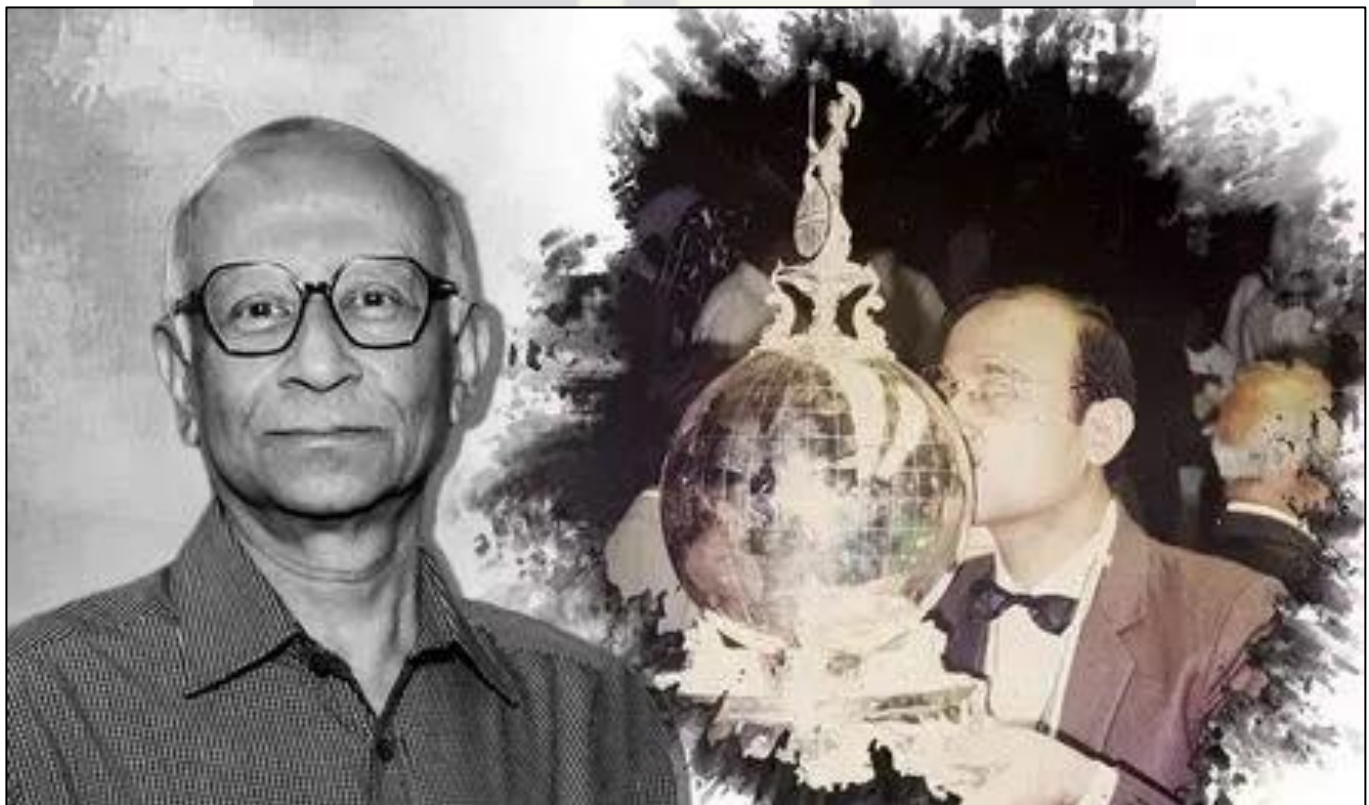

Key Points:

- **Affiliation:** Tamil Nadu
- Kothari won the World Championship in 1990.
- He was awarded the Major Dhyan Chand Award in 2005.
- Manoj Kothari's son, Saurav Kothari, also won the World Championship.
- They are the only father-son duo in the world to have won world titles in the same sport.

2.	<p>Mini Earth Observation Satellite</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Hyderabad-based startups TechMe2Space and EON Space Lab have developed a 14 kg mini Earth observation satellite.Name: MoI-1Launch: To be launched by ISRO's PSLV.It will operate in a Low Earth Orbit at an altitude of 500 km.
3.	<p>Sanjay Takale</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Sanjay Takale achieved a significant milestone in Indian motorsport with his outstanding performance in the Dakar Rally, 2026.He secured first place in Group H3 with a high average speed in the initial stages of the rally and 35th place in the car category.
4.	<p>Memorandum of Understanding between Reserve Bank and Delhi Government</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">The Delhi government has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). This brings the national capital under the RBI's full banking, cash management, and debt framework for the first time.

Impact of the agreement:

- This agreement will enable the RBI to act as the banker, debt manager, and financial agent for the Delhi government.
- It will facilitate access to facilities such as borrowing from the market through state development loans, automatic investment of surplus funds, professional cash management, and low-cost liquidity.
